 - J. Bagni reported on the meeting held November 6. The subcommittee is still working on the FAQs and will be brought before the Board prior to distribution through the major industry organizations.

- 8) Reviewed Petition for Reinstatement of licensure by Brian Jancsy
- D. Edmonds made a motion J. Bagni seconded, and the members present unanimously VOTED: to hear the petition
 - Attorney Kenneth Lakin addressed the Board on behalf of Brian Jancsy indicating he will
 provide documentation to mitigate part of the prior allegations for the Board's consideration

in connection with the petition. Mr. Jancsy also presented his case acknowledging responsibility and the impact of his past violations. The Board took the information under advisement and agreed to stay any decision until review of the documentation from Attorney Lakin and will consider a decision at the December meeting.

- 9) Board of Electricians' Appeals [open hearings, closed deliberations per M.G.L c. 30A, §18] 11:05 A.M. The Chair opened the Board of Appeals and verified the timeliness and merits of the appeal.
 - BEA-23-000006 Felix Zemel on behalf of CT Management v. Gerald Graham, Inspector of Wires, Town of Braintree
 - G. Graham participated in the hearing as the respondent.
 - The Chair swore in the parties giving testimony, accepted the exhibits, and gave each party an opportunity to present their position. The Board did not engage in deliberation during the open session. The hearing concluded at 11:54 A.M. The Chair advised the parties that the written decision would be disseminated within 45 days.

The Chair attempted to verify the timeliness and merits of the appeal however upon discovery that the appellant did not submit the appeal on the basis of the Inspector's first decision, Counsel advised that the Board may hear the appeal only on the basis of determining whether the appellant did in fact correct the installation as directed by the Inspector as the appeal is in dispute of the Inspector's decision that the installation has not been corrected to code.
