- 2) **Reviewed/Discussed** a Letter addressed to Board by Governor Maura Healey regarding regulation review.
 - Commissioner Wilkinson presented the letter from Governor Healey in which she directs the Division of Occupational Licensure's 26 Boards -create a landscape where individuals and businesses cannot just compete but can thrive in the Commonwealth— to undertake a broad scale review of their regulations relative to professional licensure and businesses with the goal of eliminating outdated regulations reducing the cost to businesses as well as licensees, to repeal unnecessary barriers or onerous requirements and rescind any regulations that stifle competition.
 - The Commissioner mentioned that in reviewing the Board's regulations one amendment was identified, however she also mentioned that the agency has issued a mass survey to licensees and associations for feedback on perceived impediments to doing business; the results of which will be shared with the Boards to assist them in consideration of other possible amendments.
 - 237 CMR14.02 (1)(a)'s requirement for licensure exams to be given in English was identified as a potential accessibility barrier and not detrimental to safety and it is proposed to strike "Examinations for licensure shall be given in the English language"
 - It was stated that this amendment would not oblige the Board to immediately provide the
 exams in other languages but only removes the restriction of any ability to do so. In
 addition, as the Board does not set language requirements of education programs it is not a
 matter for consideration.

- The members also discussed 237 CMR 15.02 (6) and agreed to clarify its intent by amendment.
- 3) Discussed/Vote on proposed regulatory changes to 237 CMR
- B. Driscoll made a motion, and it was seconded by J. Bagni, and the members unanimously
 - VOTED: to accept the proposed amendment to 237 CMR14.02 (1)(a) and 237 CMR 15.02 (6) applicants who have been previously examined by the board for a Master or Journeyman license or systems contractor or Systems Technician license and granted a license shall not be issued a license under the provisions of 237 CMR 15.00.
