### VEH110 Purchasing Guidance

Note that while supply-chain issues have been improving, buyers are advised to anticipate longer than normal lead/delivery times. Moreover, specifying features, and not specific models and trims, will enable vendors to offer wider vehicle options with faster delivery times. For example, requesting quotes for an electric pick-up truck with a minimum 7,000-pound capacity will yield more results than naming a specific brand and model. Due to fluctuations in vehicle availability, buyers should contact vendors in writing when requesting quotes and ask how long the quote is valid.

## VEH122 Advanced Vehicle Technology Equipment, Supplies and Services

VEH122 is the Statewide Contract for the acquisition of electric vehicle charging equipment and related hardware, software, and services, including electric vehicle supply equipment maintenance. The contract also offers idle reduction technologies and after-market alternative fuel conversion technologies to modify vehicles and engines to run or be supplemented by fuels or technologies that are more efficient and/or sustainable.
