Electrology Office Registration Process

To register a new Electrology office or a change in location of an Electrology office, please send the information outlined below to the Board by mail or email:

Required Documentation:

- Floor plan including:
 - Entire layout of the business, indicating rooms/equipment, front door/backdoor, bathroom location and salon set-up. Each room must be labeled with its intended purpose.
 - Owner's name & 2 phone numbers where you can be contacted
 - Name and address of business (must be the street address and not a P.O. Box)
 - Anticipated opening date
- Copy of the Electrologist's current license
- Copy of blank case history card.
- Copy of the <u>Business Certificate</u>. If business is incorporated submit a copy of the <u>Articles of Incorporation</u>, if partnership a copy of partnership agreement or <u>LLCs</u>.

Inspection:

After the submitted information has been received and approved an <u>investigator will contact the owner</u> to set up an inspection date <u>within 2 weeks of the approval date</u>. If you miss your inspection appointment your application will be denied and you will have to submit a new application to reapply.
