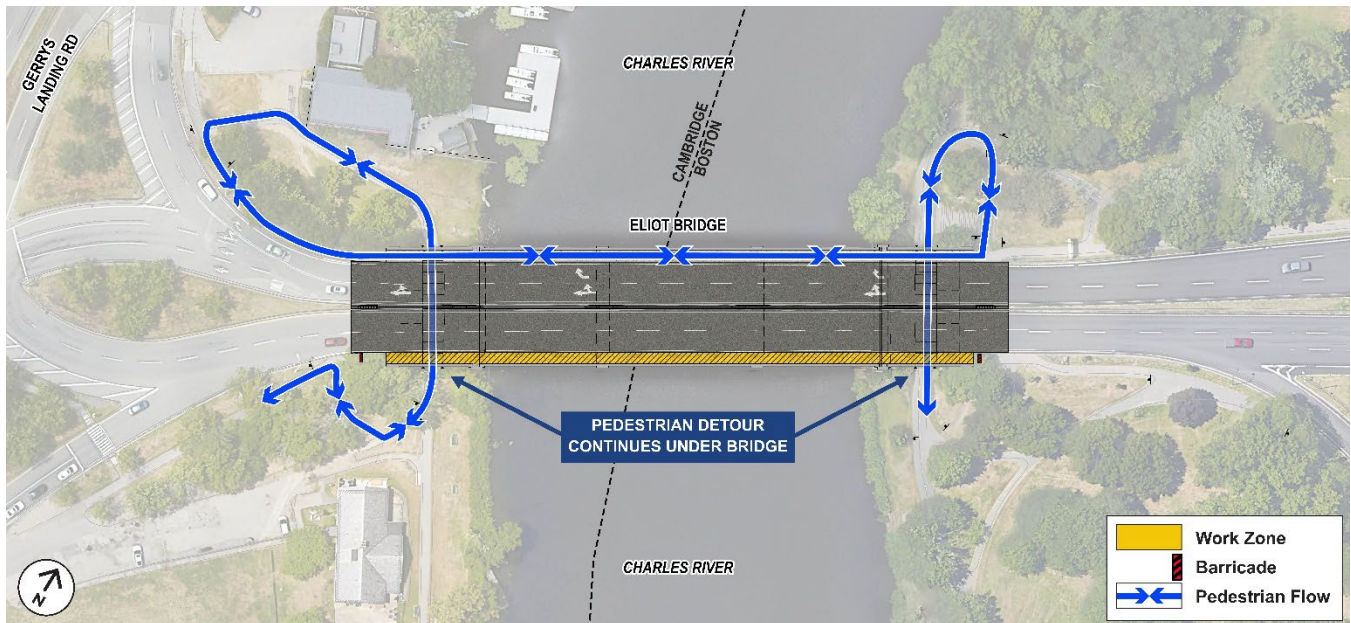
Eliot Bridge Pedestrian Detour

What is happening?

Beginning Monday, September 29, 2025, weather dependent, the Contractor will be starting repair work on the south sidewalk of Eliot Street Bridge. This area will be closed off to pedestrians until the repairs are completed. The newly repaired north sidewalk will be reopened for pedestrian use. Only one sidewalk will be closed at a time.

How will this affect you?

All pedestrians will be detoured to the north sidewalk (see detour graphic below). Signage and wayfinding will be posted accordingly. The purpose of the closure is to maintain public safety while the Contractor works on the south sidewalk.



Travel tips

Please take care to pay attention to all posted signage and message boards. Police details, changes to lane markings and/or temporary controls such as barriers and traffic cones, will be utilized throughout the duration of the project to control traffic and create safe work zones within the project limits.
