Eliot Bridge Pedestrian Underpass Closure

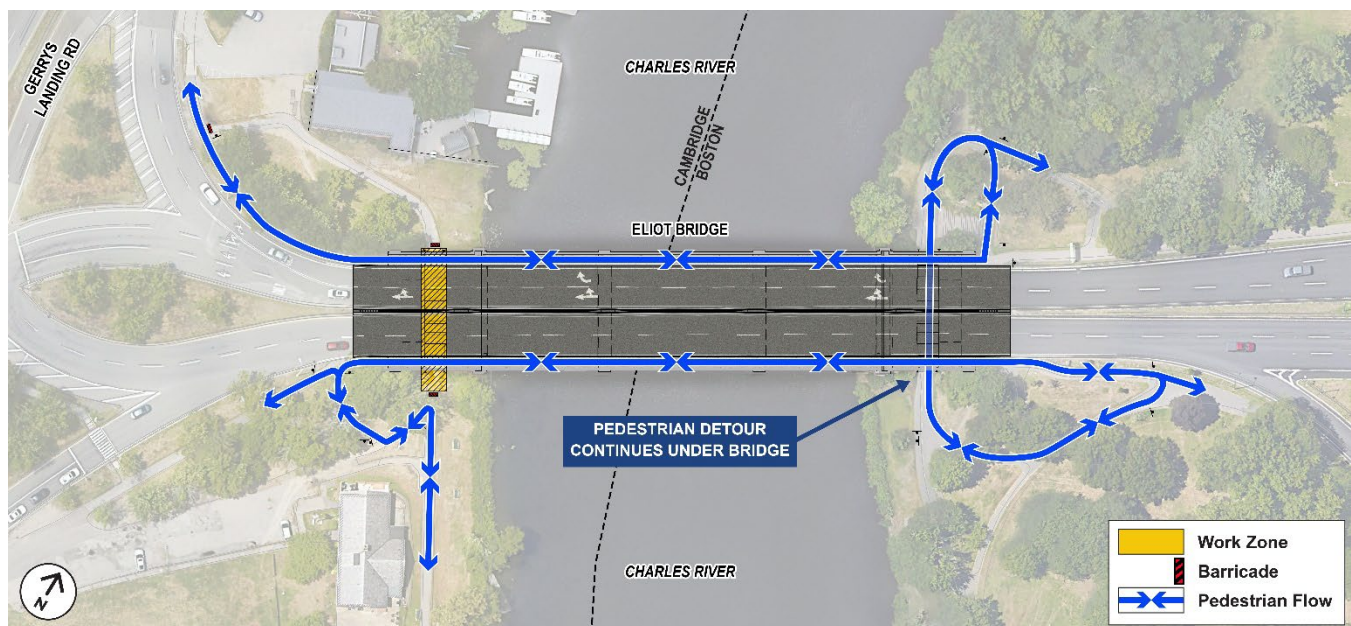
What is happening?

Beginning Monday, January 20, 2025, the Contractor will periodically close the pedestrian underpasses of the Eliot Bridge. Only one underpass will be closed at a time. The purpose of these closures is to maintain public safety while the Contractor works on the underside of the bridge deck.

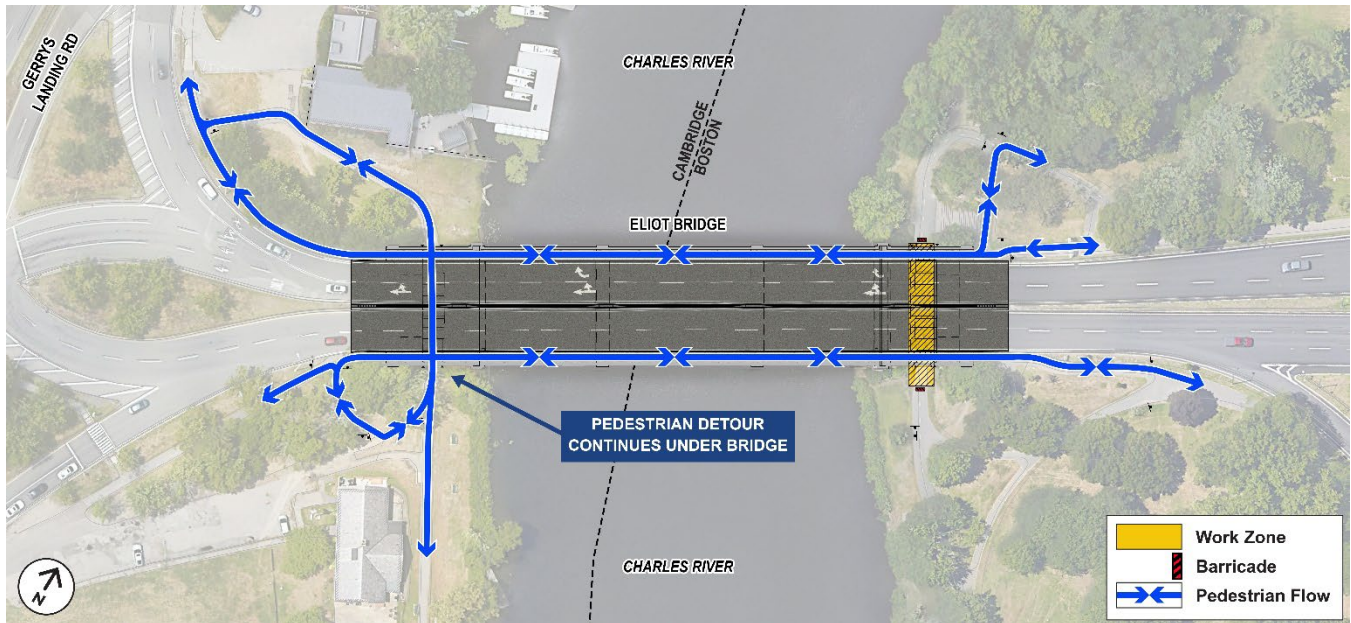
How will this affect you?

The pedestrian underpasses will periodically close to pedestrians and cyclists starting January 20. Periodic closures are anticipated to last for two weeks. One pedestrian tunnel will always remain open, and the detours shown below will be in place as applicable.
