Eliot Bridge Paving and Nightly Traffic Lane Closures Update

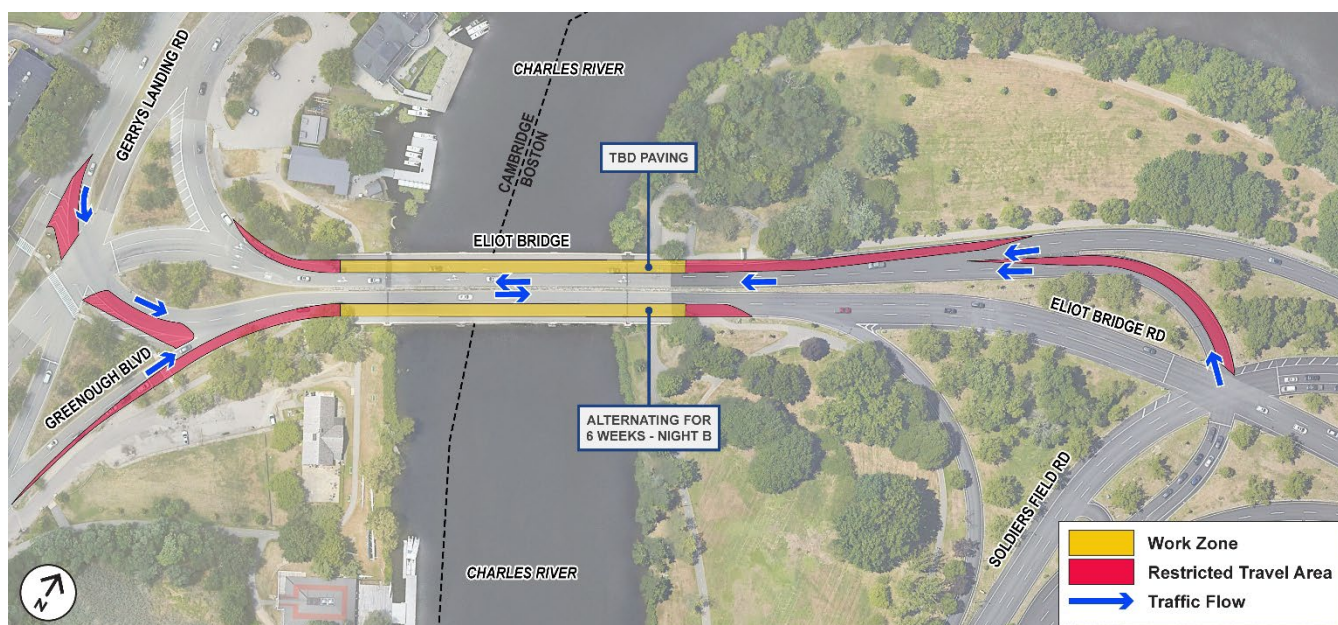
What Is Happening?

Due to weather conditions, the nighttime paving operations on the westbound lanes of Eliot Bridge, originally scheduled for September 8 and September 9, 2026, have been postponed. New dates will be shared once available.

The nighttime eastbound alternating lane closures originally scheduled to begin the week of September 13, 2026, will now begin September 8, 2026. This work is a part of the project's planned deck repairs and will take place for approximately six weeks.

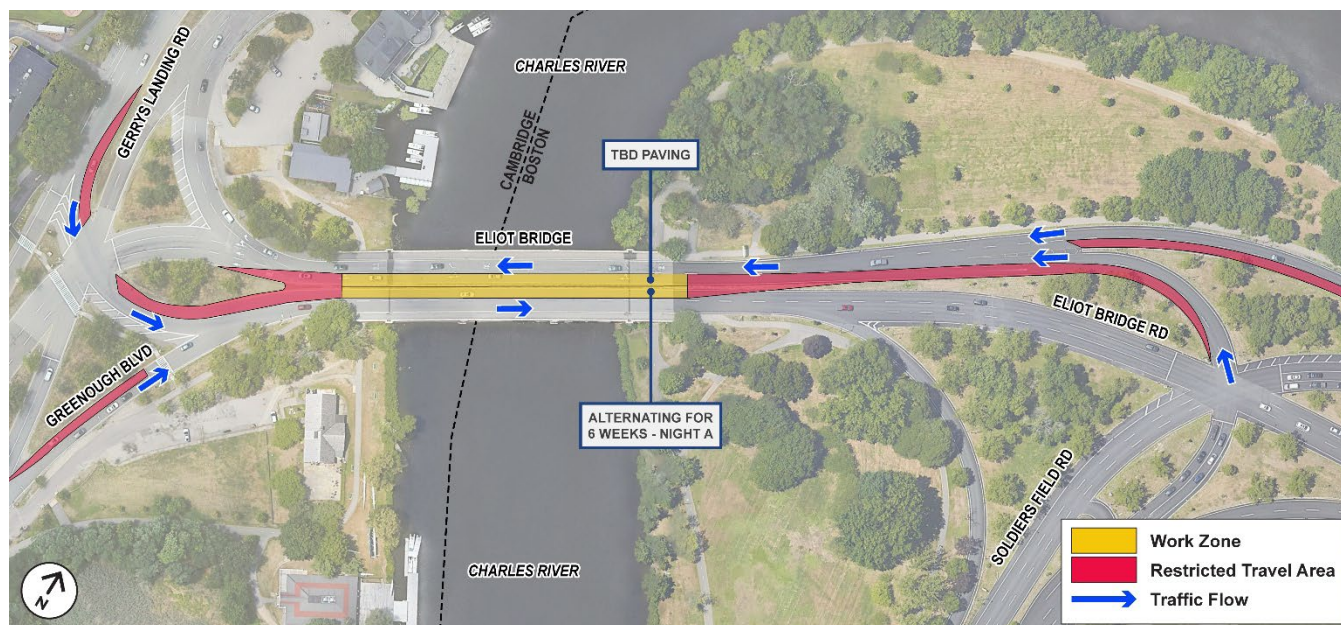
How Will This Affect You?

Beginning each night at 7 p.m., there will be a traffic shift and single lane closure on the bridge and its approaching roadways. There will only be one lane closure at a time which will alternate each night (see provided detour graphics). The area will return to its normal configuration by 5 a.m. the following morning. Traffic signage will be posted accordingly. The purpose of this closure is to maintain public safety while the contractor carries out repairs.



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Travel Tips

Please take note and pay attention to all posted signage and message boards. Police details, changes to lane markings, and/or temporary controls such as barriers and traffic cones, may be utilized throughout the duration of the project to control traffic and create safe work zones within the project limits.
