Emergency Policy on Teletherapy for Applicant Experience and Supervision Hours

At its meeting on March 20, 2020, the Board of Registration of Allied Mental Health and Human Services Professions voted to issue the following policy:

Because of the current declared state of emergency in Massachusetts, to the extent applicable for applicants of all license types, teletherapy sessions and supervision through video conferencing or telephone that occurred or will occur from March 10, 2020 through June 30, 2020 will be accepted toward experience hours and Direct Client Contact Experience or supervision requirements.
