License exam results appeal of Francesco D'Amelio Chairman Dan Kilburn introduced himself and members of the Board. Chairman Kilburn stated that he read Francesco D'Amelio's basis for the appeal and reviewed the exam. Chairman Kilburn asked if Mr. D'Amelio if he had anything to add and Mr. D'Amelio stated he has taken the exam several times and has failed by one or two questions. He thinks the hand signals are an issue for him because everyone has their own signals. He also stated he may have a learning disability and was going to be evaluated. Chairman Kilburn asked Mr. D'Amelio if he had a copy of the hoisting regulations and Mr. D'Amelio stated he did not. Chairman Kilburn stated that the hand signals are in regulation, and everyone should only be using the ones listed in regulation. Chairman Kilburn asked the other members if they had any questions, and they did not. Chairman Kilburn stated Mr. D'Amelio if he had anything additional to add and he indicated he did not. Chairman Kilburn stated that no decision would be given today and concluded the hearing. After the public hearing concluded, the Board deliberated in quasi-judicial session and unanimously denied the appeal.
