Notes About This Directory

Featured Cities:

This directory was created with the ORI's constituents in mind. As we have outlined in our annual report, many of the refugees and immigrants that use our services, are resettled into seven main cities in Massachusetts: Boston, Lynn, Lowell, Worcester, Springfield, West Springfield, and Westfield. In an effort to create a resource that is useful to this population, this directory has been organized according to those seven cities. With the goal of accessibility of ESL/ESOL classes in mind, we chose to include resources in towns and cities that were within a reasonable distance (approximately 10 miles) from the main city listed. We chose to reduce overlap by assigning a town to only one main city rather than listing any town multiple times. Each of the main cities has its own cover page within this directory that provides a list of the towns that were included in our search.

Finding a Resource:

While all of the resources outlined in this directory are organized by city, we encourage those who are searching for an ESL class to consider resources that are listed in other city sections. This is most helpful for those who live in Boston, Lynn and Lowell and might want to consider resources in all three cities, as well as those who live in Springfield, West Springfield, and Westfield.
