**NOTICE OF HEARING**

Pursuant to M.G.L. c. 112, §81E and c. 30A, §2, the Board of Registration of Professional Engineers and Land Surveyors will hold a public hearing relative to proposed promulgation of amendments to the Board's regulations located at 250 CMR 2.00, 3.00, 5.00 and 7.00, which govern the administrative and licensing provisions relative to professional engineers and land surveyors. The proposed revisions are part of a recent initiative by the Governor to streamline business operations while upholding necessary consumer protections. In particular, these amendments are designed to facilitate licensure, removing outdated language, and otherwise facilitate business with minimal regulatory barriers. A small business impact statement has been filed with the Secretary of the Commonwealth's Office.
