ICO Enrollment Process

- 1. Connection between ICO and Medicare enrollment process and timeframe
- 2. Open enrollment
 - a. Eligible population: Members who are
 - Eligible for full Medicaid benefits under MassHealth Standard or CommonHealth;
 - Enrolled in Medicare Part A and Part B;
 - 21-64 years of age at the time of enrollment;
 - No other comprehensive coverage (e.g. employer-sponsored insurance);
 - Not residing in an Intermediate Care Facility for the Mentally Retarded (ICFMR)
 - b. Dates
 - c. Process
- 3. Auto-enrollment of eligible population
 - a. Population to be auto-enrolled: Members who
 - I. Do not make a choice to opt out
 - II. Are not PACE members or Medicare Advantage members
 - III. Do not live in a service area where there is 1 ICO only
 - b. Process
 - c. Dates / Roll-out
- 4. Enrollment of new members as they become eligible
