EOHHS Congregate Care Staff Surveillance Testing at State- and Provider-Operated Sites

Note: Beginning January 18-20, 2021, both state-operated and provider-operated EOHHS Congregate Care settings began surveillance testing with Color Genomics, Inc. ("Color"). Metrics below include both state- and provider-operated settings.
