




What is considered a "Security Incident"?



The following security incidents should always be reported:

- Assault
- · Domestic dispute
- · Workplace injury
- Medical incident or emergency
- Theft
- Threats verbal or physical
- · Health and safety issues and concerns
- · Data breach
- Improper use of employee ID badge
- · Any other incident that you feel needs attention





Department of Unemployment Assistance (DUA)

DUA serves Massachusetts residents who are unemployed and looking for work and employers that are legally required to contribute to the State's unemployment insurance (UI) program.

- Process and pay UI claims timely and accurately
- Determine and collect employer contributions
- Protect the integrity of the UI trust fund
- Promote safeguards to ensure privacy and customer satisfaction
- Improve re-employment efforts

- Calculate UI rates and deposit contributions
- Develop advanced methods and systems for managing data
- Expedite UI payments
- · Provide online services
- Prevent, detect, and recover fraudulent UI payments.

The Department of Labor Relations (DLR) is responsible for promoting stable, productive and cooperative relationships between public employers and their represented employees by administering and enforcing the Commonwealth's collective bargaining laws.

Primary functions:

- 1. Adjudication of prohibited practice charges;
- 2. Processing representation cases and bargaining unit clarification cases;
- 3. Prevention and termination of strikes by public employees;
- 4. The provision of conciliation, arbitration and mediation services


