RE: Average Cost of Nursing Facility Services

Introduction

If a MassHealth applicant or member has made a disqualifying transfer of resources, MassHealth must impose a period of ineligibility for payment of nursing facility services. See 130 CMR 520.019(G)(1): *Financial Eligibility*.

When calculating the period of ineligibility, MassHealth uses the average cost to a patient paying privately for nursing facility services in the Commonwealth. Periodically, this figure is revised to reflect increased costs.

Revised Average Cost of Nursing Facility Services

Effective **November 1, 2019**, the average cost to a person paying privately for nursing facility services in the Commonwealth is being **increased** from \$366.73 to \$367.21 a day.

When calculating the period of ineligibility for a disqualifying transfer of resources, use the date that MassHealth received the application or eligibility review form in order to determine which amount should be used.

- If an application is received **before** November 1, 2019, use \$366.73
- If an application is received **on or after** November 1, 2019, use \$367.21.
