RE: Clarification of MassHealth Fair Hearing Rules Related to Aid Pending

Background

Federal Medicaid law states that if a member requests a hearing within 10 days from the date they receive a notice of action, MassHealth must reinstate and continue services until a decision is rendered after the hearing upon request.

Time Standard for Aid Pending Requests

MassHealth maintains continuous benefits for members who request aid pending within 10 days after they receive a notice of action. The date the member received the notice is considered to be five days after the date on the notice, unless the member demonstrates that the Postal Service did not deliver the notice within five days after the date on the notice. If the member did not receive notice from the Postal Service within five days after the date on the notice, they have 10 days from the date they received the notice from the Postal Service to request aid pending. See 42 CFR § 431.230.
