**RE:** **Average Daily Cost of Nursing Facility Services for Calculating a Period of Ineligibility**

### Introduction

This EOM provides the new average daily cost of nursing facility services that MassHealth will begin using on November 1, 2025, to calculate a period of ineligibility.

If a MassHealth applicant or member has made a disqualifying transfer of resources, MassHealth must impose a period of ineligibility for payment of nursing facility services. See [130 CMR 520.019\(G\)\(1\): Financial Eligibility](#).

When calculating the period of ineligibility, MassHealth uses the average daily cost to a patient paying privately for nursing facility services in the Commonwealth. Periodically, this figure is revised to reflect increased costs.

### Revised Average Daily Cost of Nursing Facility Services

Starting November 1, 2025, the average cost to a person paying privately for nursing facility services in the Commonwealth will increase from \$441.00 to \$450.00 per day.

When calculating the period of ineligibility for a disqualifying transfer of resources, use the date that MassHealth received the application or eligibility review form to determine which amount to use.

- If an application is received before November 1, 2025, use \$441.00.
- If an application is received on or after November 1, 2025, use \$450.00.
