Standard Applications and Tools

There will continue to be business case, accessibility and user-based exceptions.

EOTSS has standardized on Windows OS for end user computing, and iOS for mobile devices. Commonwealth-issued iPhones and iPads are considered mobile devices and are fully managed via <u>Intune</u> <u>MDM</u>. All other Apple devices, including Macs, personal iPhones and personal iPads, are not standard and treated as BYOD devices.

Windows Devices

All new devices will come pre-loaded with Windows 11, Microsoft Office Pro Plus, OneDrive for Business, SharePoint and Teams (Office 2016/365 Click-to-Run requires a Microsoft M365 G3 license) – as well as other tools such as the Adobe product suite. Apple Devices

All new devices will come pre-loaded with the lates version of iOS, Microsoft Office Pro Plus, OneDrive for Business, SharePoint and Teams (Office 2016/365 Click-to-Run requires a Microsoft M365 G3 license) – as well as other tools such as the Adobe product suite. Office Collaboration Tools

Please note that Microsoft Teams is the enterprise standard office collaboration tool. However, agencies can use Zoom, WebEx, GoToMeeting, and other videoconferencing and office collaboration tools if they feel that those applications best meet their needs and those of their employees and constituents.
