110.R4.1.2 Definitions. The following words and terms shall, for the purposes of 780 CMR 110.R4 and as used elsewhere in 780 CMR, have the meaning indicated in 780 CMR 110.R4.1.2.

BBRS. State Board of Building Regulations and Standards.

NATIVE LUMBER. Native lumber is wood processed in the Commonwealth of Massachusetts by a mill registered in accordance with the regulations of the BBRS. Such wood is ungraded but is stamped or certified in accordance with the requirements of the Sixth Edition of the Massachusetts State Building Code, 780 CMR 2303.1.12303. For the purpose this definition, native lumber shall be restricted to use in one-and two-story dwellings, barns, sheds, agricultural and accessary buildings and structures and other uses as permitted by 780 CMR 23.00.

110.R4.2.3 Stamp Use. Each piece of native lumber produced shall bear the producer's stamp. be stamped or certified in accordance with 780 CMR 2303.
