Program Descriptions

ADVENTURE TO BEAVER LODGE 執 作論

Let's see how nature's engineers change the landscape! Take a walk with us to a beaver lodge and see how beavers shape the environment to their needs and create habitat for others.

Meet at the contact station. Appropriate for ages 8 and up. Siblings are welcome. About 1.5 miles over mostly paved surfaces and easy terrain.

KIDLEIDOSCOPE ******

Join us each week for Kidleidoscope! We will read a short book, followed by an outdoor activity. Afterwards, enjoy a craft that relates to the story. Each week has a new theme, stop by often!

Meet next to the beach. Designed for ages 3 to 6. Siblings are welcome.

MOBILE NATURE CENTER THAT

We bring the nature center to you! Check out pelts, skulls, and other items related to the animals that live in the park. Stay for five minutes or an hour! Bring your questions.

Meet to the right of the beach. Suitable for all ages.

MUCKING ABOUT *****

Take a peek under the surface of Laurel Lake! Explore the bugs, tadpoles, newts and other creatures that live here. We'll use nets and buckets to catch (and then release!) some cool critters. Stay for five minutes or the whole time.

Meet to the left of the swimming area. Appropriate for ages 6 & up.

LAUREL LOOP HIKE 微 竹瓣

Enjoy breathtaking views, seas of mountain laurel, and get a glimpse of Mount Monadnock.

Meet at the contact station. This hike is about 1 mile over moderate terrain with several steep places. Appropriate for ages 8 and up.

SUPER SENSES HIKE 教育


Come join us on a hike where we will explore our 5 senses. See how our senses relate to the animals that call the woods home.
