# EV Charging Sign Policy Overview

- **Addendum to MassDOT Supplemental sign policy**
- **Applies to all State Highways.**
- **Charging Station Minimum Requirements:**
  - Available to general public 24 hours per day, 7 days per week
  - One CCS or J3400 DCFC port capable of supplying a minimum of 150 kW per port
  - Must be located within 3 miles of exit.

# EV Charging Sign Types

12

- **Business Logo Panels:**

- Business Logo Panels may include supplemental message for EV charging
- Existing Business Logo Panel may be modified, or a new Business Logo Panel may be added.
- Supplemental message should generally conform with example shown in Figure 2J-4 of the 11<sup>th</sup> edition of the MUTCD

- **Generic Service Signs:**

- An electric vehicle charging sign (D9-11b) may be added as a bottom plaque to:
  - an existing Business Logo sign assembly,
  - An existing Rest Area or Tourist Information Center Sign,
  - or to an existing Generic Services Sign Assembly.
- Where no existing assembly exists a new ground mounted Generic Services Assembly may be installed.

# EV Charging Sign Applications and Fees

- **Applications must be submitted to appropriate District Office:**

- **Fees:**
  - New Sign Structures Installations:
    - The entire cost for fabrication, erection and maintenance of the signs will be assumed by the applicant.
  - Add-on Panel Installations:
    - The entire cost of fabricating their legends, logos and/or arrows and any fees for MassDOT – Highway Division forces to add the logos to existing signs. or to an existing Generic Services Sign Assembly.
  - Recuring Fees: Annual fee of \$1,200.00., but waived in pro-rated fashion for applicants who pay for new sign structure so that they can recover costs.
    - Fees may be waived for municipalities or public agencies.
