

Item #1: Discussion on MassDEP Proposed Projects

PFAS data flow for NPDES and AOS data



SFY25 - Planned IT work \$164,000

Implement new GW form

• In eDEP

(where the data is uploaded)

- In PNQA (where DEP reviews the data)
- In the Public Portal (where the public can access the data)
- Update FAQ doc in Public Portal
- Update facilities list (ongoing)

This form will allow PFAS data from Groundwater Discharge facilities to be uploaded to the database once DEP requires this testing.

New facilities are developed and permitted throughout the year. These facilities will need to be added to the IT system.

Misc. Enhancements

- In eDEP
- In PNQA
- In the Public Portal

Bug fixes

Handled separately

The eDEP enhancements avoid upload errors and reflect updated PFAS testing requirements.

The PNQA enhancement improves usability.

The Public Portal enhancement enables easier data analysis.

Bug fixes for the existing system are handled separately from new enhancements, and were not part of the \$164k.

Current work status

Completed (SFY25)

- New GW form in eDEP
- New GW form in PNQA
- eDEP enhancements
- PNQA enhancements

Nearing completion (likely SFY25)

- New GW form in the Public Portal
- Public Portal enhancements

These items are nearing completion (ie. not yet completed). They will likely be completed in SFY25. The timing of this work finalization is due to IT priorities and timeline.

To be completed (SFY26)

- Update the FAQ doc in the Public Portal
- Update the GW Facilities list

IT has responded that updating the FAQ document is a light lift for them, and OK to be completed in SFY26.

The program understands from IT that updating the GW facilities list is a light lift for IT, as long as it does not need to be a rapid turnaround. We plan to update this list 2-4 times per year as needed, and have discussed this plan with IT.

SFY26 - IT funding request \$40,000

- Due to timing and uncertainty about the future bill's requirement, we want to have project contractor in place for maintenance and potential enhancements during the first year after project implementation
- The first year usually requires more IT involvement than subsequent years
