SUMMARY OF DISCUSSIONS	
	Open the Meeting: Ms. Perez opened the meeting after confirming the attendees present.
1.	 Springfield Water and Sewer Commission (SWSC) Presentation: Mr. Schimmel gave an overview on SWSC in general with a focus on the new drinking water treatment plant it is looking to build. The current drinking water treatment plants are inadequate to meet SWSC's needs due to advancing regulations, asset failure, and outdated parts that can no longer be serviced or replaced. There is about a \$150-175 million financing shortfall for building a new plant. SWSC would like to finance the \$150-175 million of funds it needs over the next 6 years through the Drinking Water State Revolving Fund (DWSRF). The first \$15 million for this project is listed on the draft 2023 DWSRF Intended Use Plan (IUP). The project is expected to go out to bid later in 2023.

DWSRF applicants are currently capped at \$15 million per IUP year. An exception to this cap is being requested to help SWSC meet its project financing needs.

Ms. Pinaud asked if project timeline can be extended.

Mr. Schimmel said that SWSC can look at the possibility of extending the timeline if the Water Infrastructure Finance and Innovation Act financing agreement it has entered with EPA will allow the project completion date to go beyond 2029.

The Executive Committee thanked Mr. Schimmel for the presentation and said staff from the Trust and DEP would be following up with requests for more information.

Other Business (Items not reasonably anticipated by the Chair 48 hours in advance of the meeting) Ms. Pinaud said that the 2023 IUPs will be finalized soon.

<u>Adjourn the Meeting:</u> Ms. Perez requested a motion to adjourn the meeting. Ms. Pinaud moved the motion. A roll call was held, and all members approved the motion.
