Overview of Fantini Bakery

Fantini Bakery is a family-owned commercial bakery that produces artisan baked goods in Haverhill, MA. This business was founded in 1902 and now distributes their products throughout New England.

Air Permit Application – Proposed Project

Fantini submitted a Non-major Comprehensive Plan Approval (Non-major CPA) to replace one of their tunnel ovens with a new tunnel oven. The proposed oven uses natural gas to operate. There is no expected increase in air emissions.

Air Permit Application and Public Involvement

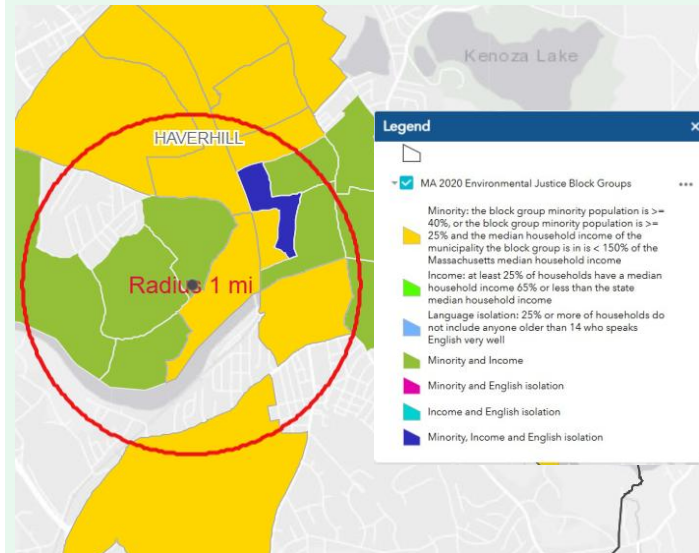
