

## **Underground Storage Tank Program Fact Sheet**

## Installs, Removals, and Closure in Place --- Notification Requirements

Massachusetts' UST regulations, <u>310 CMR 80.00</u>, establish a number of notification requirements for installations, removals, and closures in place. The following information provides a brief summary of those requirements.

- ✓ <u>Installations</u>. Within 30 days of putting regulated substance (e.g., motor vehicle fuel) in a tank, owners/operators must notify MassDEP and submit installation documentation. Please notify MassDEP by registering or updating your tank information at <u>MassDEP's online tank registration system</u>. Installation documents may be sent via email to <u>DEP.UST@mass.gov</u>. More detailed information can be found at <u>MassDEP's tank installation fact sheet</u>.
- ✓ <u>Removals</u>. Within 90 days of the tank or equipment removal date, owners/operators must notify MassDEP of the removal and must submit a removal assessment report. Please notify MassDEP by updating your tank information at <u>MassDEP's online tank registration system</u>. Removal assessments may be sent via email to <u>DEP.UST@mass.gov</u>.
- ✓ <u>Closure in Place</u>. MassDEP's UST Program reviews the applicability of all closure in place requests. If you are considering closure in place of a tank, please contact the UST Program via email at <a href="mailto:DEP.UST@mass.gov">DEP.UST@mass.gov</a> or via phone at <a href="mailto:617-556-1036">617-556-1036</a> before developing or submitting a determination/request.
