**DECISION**

**DOS NINOS, INC. DBA ANEJO MEXICAN BISTRO**  
**188 MAIN STREET**  
**FALMOUTH, MA 02540**

Dos Ninos, Inc. dba Anejo Mexican Bistro (the "Licensee") holds an alcohol license issued pursuant to M.G.L. c. 138, §12. The Alcoholic Beverages Control Commission (the "Commission") held a hearing on Tuesday, September 4, 2012, regarding an alleged violation of 204 CMR 2.05(2), to wit: c.138, §34. Prior to the commencement of the hearing, the licensee stipulated to the violation alleged in Investigator Binienda's Compliance Check Field Report.

The following documents are in evidence:

1. Investigator Binienda's Compliance Check Field Report dated May 21, 2012; and
2. Licensee's Stipulation of Facts.
  - A. Roster of Employees Who Participated in TIPS On-Premises Training; and
  - B. TIPS Certificate for Christopher Joseph.

There is one (1) audio recording of this hearing.

**FACTS**

1. On Monday, May 21, 2012, at approximately 6:26 p.m., Investigators Kenny and Binienda conducted an investigation of the business operation of Dos Ninos, Inc. dba Anejo Mexican Bistro.
2. An underage operative working with investigators purchased an alcoholic beverage, a Bud beer for four dollars and eighty-one cents (\$4.81). The underage operative was not asked for identification.


**CONCLUSION**

Based on the evidence, the Commission finds the licensee violated 204 CMR 2.05 (2), to wit: M.G.L. c. 138, §34. Therefore the Commission **suspends the license for three (3) days of which three (3) days will be held in abeyance for a period of two (2) years provided no further violations of Chapter 138 or Commission Regulations occur.**

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
