RATES AND CHARGES

The following rates, charges and rules apply to Carrier's transportation of Household goods, Furniture and Office Equipment, as defined herein, within the Commonwealth of Massachusetts. If Carrier has issued an estimate prior to shipment, the rates, charges and rules in this tariff shall apply and shall supersede those in the estimate. If Shipper should have any questions as to how the final charges will be calculated or how they are expected to be paid, please call Carrier at (617) 776-1700.

Item 1 – Hourly Rates: Addendum A hereto shows Carrier's calendar for Off Peak, Peak and Prime Peak days. Prices listed below are the hourly rates for 3 men plus 1 truck.

- (a) Any time in excess of 8 hours in a single day shall be charged at a rate of 1.5 times the hourly rate shown in Item 1 table below.

Item 2 – Computation of Time:

- (a) Time is computed from the time the vehicle and helpers report at the original point of loading until the completion of unloading the last load at the final destination, less the time spent for meals or vehicle breakdown. There will be a 2 hour labor minimum for all jobs and once this 2 hour minimum is satisfied, charges accrue pro-rated to the half hour. An additional charge shall be assessed for each vehicle, helper(s) or supervisor(s) to cover their travel time. Such charge shall not be assessed more than once during any one day to the same shipper for the same vehicle, helper(s) or supervisor(s). Travel time charges shall be calculated as follows:

(b) Travel Time:

Standard travel time on all jobs is 1 (one) hour. Exceptions to standard travel see below:

- (A) Over 25 miles up to and including 50 miles.....Add 1/2 hour
- (B) Over 50 miles up to and including 75 miles.....Add 1 hour
- (C) Over 75 miles up to and including 100 miles.....Add 2 hours

(D) Over 100 miles up to and including 150 miles.....Add 3 hours

Item 3 – Accessorial Services and Charges: In addition to the hourly charges identified above and the charges for those accessorial services described in Addendum B hereto, the following charges shall apply:

(a) Hoisting:

Carrier hoists only to/from 2nd (second) stories. Hoists to/from 3 (three) stories and above will need to be done by an outside contractor at the additional cost of the consumer.

Two (2) stories or less.....\$75.00 for first item; \$50.00 for each additional item

(b) Piano or Organ Handling:

Baby Grand Piano and Pipe Organs

First floor to first floor.....\$125.00 per item

Each additional set of stairs (7 steps).....\$ 50.00

Upright Pianos, Spinets and other Organs

First floor to first floor.....\$100.00 per item

Each additional set of stairs (7 steps).....\$ 50.00

(c) Packing Materials: As shown in Addendum B.

(d) Packing Services (Labor): At the Hourly Rates as shown in Item 1(a).

(e) Storage:

(i) On truck - \$150 for the first night with a \$50 per day charge for every day thereafter.

(ii) In warehouse - \$ 75 per storage vault per month, plus unloading and re-loading charges at the Hourly Rates as shown in Item 1(a).

(f) Fuel Surcharge: A fuel surcharge of 10% shall be applied to the Hourly Rates shown in Item 1(a), excluding charges for packing services.

Item 4 – Methods of Payment: At or before the time of delivery of a shipment, Shipper must pay all applicable charges due under this tariff by cash, certified check, bank check or credit card.

Item 5 – Carrier’s Lien:

(a) Carrier shall have the right to retain possession of any property transported by it and to take and place the same in storage at the charge and expense of the Shipper until all tariff rates and charges thereon have been paid in cash, money order, certified check, or credit card. Nothing herein shall limit the right of Carrier to require, at a time of or before shipment, the prepayment in part or in full or a guarantee of the charges.

(b) Property not received by the Shipper after appropriate notice, may be kept in a vehicle, warehouse or place of business of the Carrier, subject to all lawful charges and to Carrier’s responsibility as warehouseman only, or at the option of the Carrier, may be removed to and stored in a warehouse at the point of delivery or at other available points at the cost of the owner, and there held without liability on the part of the Carrier, and subject to a lien for all transportation and other lawful charges, including a reasonable charge for storage. In the event the Consignee or owner cannot be found at the address given on the bill of lading for notification, Carrier shall be discharged from liability upon sending a notice to Shipper showing the warehouse in which such property has been placed, subject to the provisions of this paragraph.

(c) Where Carrier is directed to take property from a place or places at which the Shipper, consignor or his agent is not present, the property shall be at the risk of the Shipper or owner before loading.

(d) Where Carrier is directed to unload or deliver property at a place or places at which the Shipper, owner or consignee or his agent is not present, the property shall be at the risk of the Shipper or owner after unloading or delivery.

(e) Shipper, owner or consignee shall be liable for and shall pay the advances, tariff charges, packing and storage, if any, and all other lawful charges accruing on said property. Carrier shall not deliver or relinquish possession at destination of the shipment until all tariff charges thereon have been paid. Shipper shall also be liable for the advances, tariff charges, packing, storage, and all other lawful charges, except as otherwise agreed in writing. Nothing herein shall limit the right of Carrier to require, at the time of delivery of the shipment, payment of the charges in full.

Item 6— Limitation of Carrier’s Liability: Carrier’s liability for cargo loss, damage or delay under this tariff is limited as stated herein. Shipper must declare, on the bill of lading, one of the following two options to establish Carrier’s maximum liability for any goods lost, damaged or delayed in transit:

OPTION A – Released Value: Under this Option, the Shipper declares and agrees that the goods are transported and/or stored by Carrier at a released value of \$0.60 (Sixty Cents) per pound, per article, which shall be Carrier’s maximum liability. There is no additional charge for this Option.

OPTION B – Full Value Protection: Under this Option, if any goods are lost or damaged while in Carrier’s custody, Carrier will either (i) repair the article to the extent necessary to restore it to the same condition as when it was received by Carrier or the Carrier pays Shipper the cost of such repairs; or (ii) replace the article with an article of like kind and quality, or pay the cost of such a replacement, whichever is less. There is an additional charge for this Option. Call Carrier at (617) 776-1700 for added valuation charges. **NOTE: Valuation charges under this Option are not insurance.**

Item 7 – Articles of Extraordinary Value: Carrier will not carry or be liable in any way for any documents, specie or for any high-value article or article of extraordinary value unless Carrier has signed a special agreement to do so, a stipulated value of the articles is stated by Shipper on the Bill of Lading and additional charges are paid by Shipper for such valuation. A high-value article or “article of extraordinary value” are hereby defined as any item in the shipment valued at more than \$100 per pound.

Item 8 - Special, Incidental or Consequential Damages. Under no circumstances will Carrier be liable for any special, incidental, indirect or consequential damages, including but not limited to loss of income, lost profits or market, lost opportunity or sentimental value, in excess of the limits described in Item 6 above, whether or not Carrier had knowledge that such damage(s) might be incurred.

Item 9 – Cargo Loss, Damage and Delay Claim Rules:

(a) As a condition precedent to recovery, claims for loss or damage must be filed in writing with Carrier and must include sufficient information to identify the shipment and must set forth a specified or determinable amount of money claimed.

(b) Claims for loss or damage must be filed within fifteen (15) days after the delivery of the shipment, except that claims for failure to make delivery must be filed within fifteen (15) days after a reasonable time for delivery has elapsed.

(c) Suits for loss, damage, injury or delay must be instituted against Carrier no later than two (2) years and one day from the day when written notice is given to the claimant that the carrier has disallowed the claim or any part or parts of the claim specified in the notice. Where claims are not filed or suits are not instituted thereon in accordance with the foregoing provisions, Carrier shall not be liable, and such claims will not be paid.

Item 10 – Overcharge Claim Rules: All overcharge claims must be filed by Shipper with Carrier within thirty (30) days of delivery of the shipment or Carrier’s invoice for freight charges, if any, whichever is later. Such overcharge claims must be in writing and specify in detail the basis for the claimed overcharge. All lawsuits for overcharges must be filed by Shipper within two years of the date of delivery of the shipment.

Item 11 – Definitions:

The term “Household goods, Furniture and Office Equipment” as used in this tariff means: The transportation of furniture and household goods in whole or in part incident to a move by a householder to or from a dwelling and a storage warehouse, from one dwelling to another, or within a location, and of office equipment or property of a commercial establishment incident to the removal of an establishment in whole or in part from one location to another, or within a location.

The term “Carrier” as used in this Tariff means PR Taylor Enterprises, LLC d/b/a Father & Son Moving and Storage.

The term “Shipper” as used in this Tariff means the person who is the owner of the household goods or who has a beneficial interest in the household goods or property transported by Carrier.

Item 12- Estimates/Quotations:

Carrier does not quote binding estimates. Carrier may give Shipper a written estimate, but in doing so the final charges to be assessed shall be in accordance with the actual services performed in accordance with the rates and charges published in this tariff. In no event, however, will the final charges exceed 125% of the estimated charges.
