Re: Revised Advisory Ruling 9305: Foot Care

At the February 14, 2018 Board of Registration in Nursing (Board) meeting, the Board revised Advisory Ruling 9305: *Foot Care* to ensure compliance with current statutes, regulations and scope of practice standards.

AR 9305 guides the practice of Registered Nurses and Licensed Practical Nurses whose practice incorporates foot care to meet nursing and client goals including, but not limited to, health promotion, client teaching, health risk reduction, and promotion of safety and comfort.

Based on its review of relevant statutes and regulations, position statements published by professional nursing and health care organizations, scientific, peer-reviewed literature, the Board voted unanimously to revise AR 9305 to:

- 1) Require competency acquisition in:
 - a) Assessing health habits affecting feet and lower extremities (activity level, exercise, obesity, diet, smoking, etc.); and
 - b) Assessing pain and methods of relief.
- 2) Include the provision of off-loading or pressure relief devices for intact skin as a nursing measure, not requiring an order from a duly authorized prescriber.
- 3) Update technical revisions to grammar and style.
- 4) Update references.
