

MINUTES

February 22, 2021

A Meeting of the Commissioners of the Cape Cod Mosquito Control Project (CCMCP) was held via Zoom call on February 22, 2021. In participation was: Superintendent Gabrielle Sakolsky-Hoopes, Assistant Superintendent Barton Morris, Entomologist Aubrey Paolino, Chairman J. Gregory Milne, Vice-Chairman Rodney Collins, Secretary Arthur Neill, and Commissioners Jim Quirk and Emily Beebe.

Commissioner Quirk made a motion to approve the minutes of January 25, 2021, 2nd by Vice-Chairman Collins. The motion was approved unanimously by way of roll call.

Superintendent Sakolsky informed the Board of the upcoming Mosquito Control Task Force meeting, scheduled for March 3rd, 2021.


Superintendent Sakolsky updated the Board on the NMCA Meeting series, held virtually in January and February 2021, which had 168 attendees. The Association is hoping for the December 2021 meeting to be held in-person at the Cape Codder Resort in Hyannis, MA.

Current field work and COVID procedures were reviewed and discussed.

Employee evaluations were completed and a 3% wage increase to all employees was recommended. Commissioner Quirk made a motion to approve the 3% increase, 2nd for discussion by Vice-Chairman Collins. The motion was amended to include an effective date of March 1, 2021. This increase is in lieu of a COLA and merit increase. Motion passed unanimously by way of roll call.

The next meeting date is set for Monday, March 29, 2021 at 2:00PM, to be held remotely via Zoom.

There being no further business, Commissioner Quirk moved to adjourn, 2nd by Vice-Chairman Collins and approved unanimously by way of roll call.
