Join us at a Public Meeting on the FEIR for the expansion of South Station. The FEIR includes a preferred South Station Expansion alternative, summarizes the changes to the project since the Draft Environmental Impact Report (DEIR) filing in 2014, responds to DEIR comments, and incorporates additional environmental analyses outlined in the Certificate on the DEIR. The proposed project would acquire and demolish the USPS facility; reopen Dorchester Ave. and extend the Harborwalk; expand the South Station terminal; improve reliability and meet current and future commuter rail and intercity rail service needs; and create new layover capacity.
