- OGR issued on 4/9/20 notice of a revised Attachment A Application document to all applicants that submitted letters of intent for this AGF. The new application document is at https://www.mass.gov/service-details/traffic-safety-grants.
- The AGF is now amended to require all those awarded Section 405-c funding from it to provide
 monthly expenditure and activity reports during their contract/ISA periods. There will be no
 option for quarterly reporting. Monthly expenditure reporting is necessary for OGR to comply
 with the non-central draw requirements of Massachusetts Comptroller's Office.
- For the e-applications due by 4/16/20, OGR will accept electronic versions of hand signatures and dates on AGF response documents. For the hard-copy submissions, due by 4/28/20, AGF response documents must be hand-signed and dated in blue ink.
