FINAL DECISION AND ORDER

This matter came before the Board for disposition on the basis of the Administrative Magistrate's Recommended Decision, dated April 5, 2021, which is attached hereto and incorporated by reference. After hearing from the Parties and after full consideration of the Recommended Decision, Petitioner's Objections to the Recommended Decision, and the Respondent's Responses to the Petitioner's Objections to the Recommended Decision, the Board ADOPTS the Recommended Decision, finding that the Board has not proven by a preponderance of the evidence that the Respondent treated Members A, B, C, D and E in a manner that fell below the standard of care with respect to the necessity and scope of preparticipation physicals for extended international travel conducted during the period in which Members A through E were treated. As such, the Board dismisses the Statement of Allegations and the Amended Statement of Allegations, and, in accordance with M.G.L. c.112, §5, exonerates the Respondent. This Final Decision and Order is effective Nunc Pro Tunc to September 9, 2021.
