Purpose:	To notify Local Workforce Boards, One-Stop Career Center Operators and other local workforce partners of the announcement of the Release of the Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act (WIOA) Final Rules and Information Collections for WIOA and Additional DOL Administered Programs through Training and Employment Notice (TEN) No. 42-15.
Background:	In response to the passage of WIOA, the U.S. Departments of Labor (DOL) and Education are making publicly available five rules implementing its provisions and established Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act Common Performance Reporting, which aligns WIOA required data and reporting for WIOA core programs administered by DOL; Adults, Youth, Dislocated Worker programs under title I of WIOA and the Wagner-Peyser Act of 1933, as amended by WIOA; as well as programs administered by the Department of Education, the Adult Education and Family Literacy Act and the Rehabilitation Act of 1973, as amended by WIOA. Further, the DOL established Information Collections for all programs authorized by WIOA title I and additional DOL administered programs.
	The <u>Final Rules</u> are available currently through the Department of Labor. In the coming weeks they will also be published in the Federal Register and incorporated into the Code of Federal Regulations.
