

SUMMARY OF NO. 26-06

This proposed law would specify that employees of the state Senate and state House of Representatives, other than those falling within certain excluded categories, are permitted to form unions to collectively bargain with their employer.

Under the proposed law, the state Ethics Commission would establish exclusions and procedures to address any perceptions of a conflict of interest for the union representing public employees in collective bargaining.

The proposed law states that, if any of its parts were declared invalid, the other parts would stay in effect.
