

SUMMARY OF NO. 26-18

This proposed law would allow drivers who have lifetime disqualifications from holding a driver's license because of a refusal to take a breath or blood test and/or multiple convictions for operating under the influence to receive a waiver that would make them eligible for a driver's license after serving at least ten years of their lifetime disqualification. The proposed law authorizes the Registry of Motor Vehicles to issue guidelines or regulations to administer the waiver program.
