- Rape Crisis Centers have free counseling, support groups and other help for survivors of sexual assault – both in-person and online.
- You can call a rape crisis center to get help for something that just happened, or for something that happened a long time ago.
- Friends and family members can also call or go to a Rape Crisis Center if they have concerns about a loved one.
