The Division of Banks issued three Consent Orders during the first quarter of 2016:

Community Mortgage Services, Inc. was issued a **Consent Order** related to violations of laws and regulations applicable to the conduct of a mortgage broker.

Western Sky, LLC/CashCall Settlement (Update):

On October 26, 2015, the Massachusetts Division of Banks and Massachusetts Attorney General Maura Healey reached a \$2.4 million settlement with small installment loan and payday lenders, their affiliated companies and owners. The payment process is underway and approximately \$2.28 million has been distributed to Massachusetts consumers. This represents a payout of 1633 claims with 212 claims outstanding. After June 2016, any unclaimed funds will be paid over to the Commonwealth Treasurer's Office as unclaimed property in the name of the consumers, in accordance with Massachusetts law.
