Application of This Document

Purpose: This tariff has in full detail all First-Rate Moving's (FRM) rates, charges, and service terms related to all aspects of their business.

Included: intrastate, interstate, packing related charges, storage rates, valuation coverage costs, as well as specialty item charges.

This document governs all sections of this tariff unless otherwise provided within an individual section of an amendment.

Carrier is authorized under this tariff to provide services based on either binding OR non-binding estimates. Charges for shipments may be based upon Weight in Pounds, Cubic Feet Occupied by Shipper's property. Moreover, carrier may charge based on an hourly rate.

Shipping Documents: All Bills of Lading, Written Agreements, Valuation Coverage Documents, Inventory Template Sheets, are incorporated and applicable in this tariff for reference.

Brokers: FRM is a private and independent Moving Company. We do not work with Brokers and have no Van-Line affiliation. If we are unable to service a move for any reason and recommend to the shipper to call a separate carrier, we may not be held responsible in any form or way by the shipper. It is simply a passing along of information to benefit the Shipper with a referral.

I. Intrastate Moves

Definition: An intrastate move is any move that is contained within state lines.

Ex. Windham, NH (origin) to Manchester, NH (destination)

- A. Non-Peak Rates (Rates provided to Shipper between October 15th to April 14th)

- 1. Hourly Rates (\$60.00 Per Mover / Per Hour)

Labor Costs (Movers)	Per Hour
2 Man Crew	\$120.00
3 Man Crew	\$180.00

One Hour Minimum of Flat-Rate Travel time is included on each move and travel over 1 hour is billed in increments of 30 minutes

Example 1.

A 3 Man Crew works 15 minutes from our origin (Windham, NH) from 9 am to 12pm. The charges are as following.

3 Man Crew = \$180 Per Hour X 3 Hours = \$540

One hour flat-rate travel time for the crew. \$540 + \$180 = \$720.00.

Example 2.

A 3 Man Crew works 1:45 minutes from our origin (Windham, NH) from 9 am to 12pm. The charges are as following.

3 Man Crew = \$180 Per Hour X 3 Hours = \$540

Plus the additional 3.5 hours or travel-time for the crew. \$540 + \$630 = \$1170.00.

2. Cubic Feet Based Pricing

Definition: Cubic Feet Pricing is based on the actual space (Cubic Feet) of what the Shipper has based on their inventory of what is being moved by the Carrier.

One Hour Minimum of Flat-Rate Travel time is included on each move and travel over 1 hour is billed in increments of 30 minutes

- a) Moves where the access point of the clients exit/entry from there home is 50 feet (50') or less, the rate for the Shipper is 40 Cubic Feet Per Hour / Per Man

A 3 Man Crew works 15 minutes from our origin (Windham, NH) from 9 am to 12pm. The charges are as following.

3 Man Crew = \$210 Per Hour X 3 Hours = \$630

One hour flat-rate travel time for the crew. $\$630 + \$210 = \$840.00$.

Example 2.

A 3 Man Crew works 1:45 minutes from our origin (Windham, NH) from 9 am to 12pm. The charges are as following.

3 Man Crew = $\$210$ Per Hour X 3 Hours = $\$630$

Plus the additional 3.5 hours or travel-time for the crew. $\$630 + \$735 = \$1365.00$.

2. Cubic Feet Based Pricing

Definition: Cubic Feet Pricing is based on the actual space (Cubic Feet) of what the Shipper has based on their inventory of what is being moved by the Carrier.

One Hour Minimum of Flat-Rate Travel time is included on each move and travel over 1 hour is billed in increments of 30 minutes

- a) Moves where the access point of the clients exit/entry from there home is 50 feet (50') or less, the rate for the Shipper is 40 Cubic Feet Per Hour / Per Man

II. Interstate Moves

Definition: An interstate move is any move that requires moving beyond state lines.

Interstate Pricing Does not come into effect unless distance from Origin (Windham, NH) to Shippers Origin, then delivery to Shippers Destination is a total of 300 Driving Miles one way. This does not factor in driving time there and back but only one way driving distance.

A. Example

Windham, NH to Manchester, NH (Shipper Origin) to Schnectady, NY (Shipper Destination) is a total of 239 one way driving miles. Schnectady, NY to Windham, NH is 206 Miles. Even though the move is crossing state lines (Interstate) the normal Intrastate pricing would apply.

Windham, NH to Fredericksburg, VA is a total of 519 Driving Miles. This is a move crossing state lines and over the minimum of 300 miles to switch pricing from Intrastate to Interstate.

B. Pricing Based on Space Reservation (Peak Rates)

2. Example:

Shipment Details:

Volume: 1400 Cubic Feet / Origin: Salem, NH / Destination: Miami, FL / Distance: 1523.1 Miles

How to Calculate Shipping Cost: \$8.40 is the cost as you can see on the table when lining up a shipment of 1400 Cubic Feet going 1,500 Miles from Origin to Destination.

With the Total Distance being 1,523.1 Miles, you need to calculate the difference in the distance into your shipping rate.

How to Calculate using the graph:

$$\$8.40 / 1500 \text{ Miles} = .0056$$

Use the number of .0056 and Multiply That by total for the shipment which is 1,523.1.

This brings you to a cost of \$8.53 Per Cubic Foot (1400 CF Shipment) to ship your Household Goods 1,523.1 Miles.

COST CALCATION (1,400 CF * \$8.53 Per CF) = COST OF \$11,942.00
