## FISCAL YEAR 2018

### PAYMENT SCHEDULE FOR CHERRY SHEET PROGRAMS

Starting July 2017, Charter School Tuition assessments and reimbursements will occur monthly. Previously they did not occur until December. Because they were not assessed monthly, the State Comptroller's Office had to override the payments to charter schools due to many rejected payments. This caused the charter account balance to be negative until the end of the fiscal year, which the Comptroller determined to be in conflict with state law.

Therefore, the State Comptroller has requested that the tuition payments and assessment be reconciled on a monthly basis. Although this means a change to sending district cash flow, it will have no impact on the budget. Since these estimates are included in the cherry sheet, districts are already budgeting for this expense and raising the amount on the tax rate recapitulation sheet. As always, final actual tuition payments, assessments and reimbursements will reflect updated enrollment changes.
