Forensic Peer Support Training provides a comprehensive and realistic approach to facilitate peer support and advocacy within the criminal justice system. Using a dialogue-driven process, participants are given opportunities to develop their voice and connect with others.

Grounded in the recovery philosophy, peer support principles and guided exercises using the Sequential Intercept Model, this training is designed to focus participants on the system and culture of justice system involvement.

Training Goals

- **Define** the role of peer support within the justice system
- **Discuss** the critical skills required for effective peer support within the Justice system
- **Demonstrate** use of the Sequential Intercept Model approach to support justice- involved individuals
- **Identify** the resources needed to effectively engage and navigate the justice system
- **Practice** developing plans to address the challenges and impact of the culture of incarceration on behavior
