Instructions

Under Massachusetts law, all purchasers of motor vehicles acquired for use, storage or consumption in Massachusetts are required to pay a sales or use tax unless a specific exemption is provided. However, any person to whom a motor vehicle title is transferred as a result of a contest, drawing or raffle may be exempt from the sales or use tax. To qualify for this exemption, you must meet all the requirements of the law and complete this affidavit. To be valid, all items on Form MVU-21 must be completed. Please print or type all items except signatures.
