Nationstar Mortgage, LLC d/b/a Mr. Cooper entered into a Consent Order to resolve allegations of substantial non-compliance with applicable state and federal laws and regulations governing the conduct of those engaged in the business of mortgage servicing.

Decision Mortgage Company, Inc. had its mortgage license suspended for failure to maintain a surety bond.

David Kravets entered into a Consent Order to resolve allegations of failure to renew his mortgage loan originator license.

Poli Mortgage Group, Inc. entered into a Consent Order to resolve allegations of substantial non-compliance with applicable state laws and regulations governing the conduct of those engaged in the business of a mortgage lender and mortgage broker.

The Division terminated the following Consent Orders:

Lendingclub Corporation and Springstone Financial LLC: Consent Order of March 1, 2018 was terminated on December 17, 2020. MLD Mortgage Inc., d/b/a The Money Store: Consent Order of October 28, 2011 was terminated on December 1, 2020. Semper Home Loans, Inc.: Consent Order of January 23, 2019 was terminated on November 24, 2020.

The Division collected a total of **<u>\$157,705.88</u>** in administrative penalties.

Consumer Reimbursements

The Division reimbursed **<u>\$2,234,669.74</u>** to **<u>2,784</u>** affected consumers.

News and Updates

- On December 16, 2020 the Massachusetts Division of Banks joined other state regulators and the U.S. Secret Service in issuing a ransomware mitigation tool for nonbank companies. The ready-to-use ransomware tool will allow nonbank financial institution leadership, as well as outside security consultants and auditors, to assess an organization's efforts to control and mitigate risks associated with the threat of ransomware and identify gaps that require increased security. - The Division joined with other state financial regulators, the Bankers Electronic Crimes Task Force, and the U.S. Secret Service, to issue a self-assessment tool to banks in an effort to help mitigate ransomware attacks. Using the ransomware tool, a bank can assess its efforts to control and mitigate risks associated with the threat of ransomware and identify gaps that require increased security.
