

Cigarette Fire Investigation Checklist (FP-38)

On January 1, 2008, fire standard compliant (FSC) cigarettes became the law in Massachusetts. The State Fire Marshal has asked the State Police Commander of the Fire Investigation Unit (FIU) to make it unit policy to determine, whenever possible, if cigarettes involved in fires were fire standard compliant or not. Local fire chiefs are asked to adopt similar policies locally. This information is considered most probable based on the initial results of the investigation.
