CONSENT AGREEMENT

The Board of Registration in Pharmacy ("Board") and Fred Khayut, R.Ph. ("Registrant"), a pharmacist registered by the Board (Pharmacist Registration No. 26990, do hereby stipulate and agree that the following information shall be entered into and become a permanent part of the file of the Registrant which is maintained by the Board:

1. The parties enter into this Consent Agreement ("Agreement") in order to resolve disputed matters arising out of a complaint pending against the Registrant before the Board as Docket No. PH-07-093 (the "Complaint").
2. The Complaint alleges that on or about September 19, 2006, Registrant plead guilty to one count of Motor Vehicle Homicide by Negligent Operation in violation of M.G.L. c. 90, § 24G in Brookline District Court and was ordered to complete 200 hours of community service, 10 year loss of drivers license, and placed on probation for the three-year period thru September 18, 2009.
3. Accordingly, the Registrant freely agrees to the following terms for licensure by the Board as a pharmacist:
 - a. Registrant agrees that his pharmacist registration will be issued by the Board on PROBATIONARY STATUS for a minimum period commensurate with the court ordered probation term on the Date the Board issues the registration ("Probationary Period"). Termination of the Probationary Period shall be governed by Paragraph 4 of the Agreement; and
 - b. Registrant agrees to return a signed copy of this Agreement to the Board within ten days of receipt.
4. Registrant agrees that the termination of the Probationary Period referenced in Paragraph 3 shall be granted only if Registrant has satisfied the following conditions:


- a. Not sooner than August 18, 2009, Registrant must apply in writing to the Board for the termination of the Probation Period; and
- b. Registrant must have fully complied with all terms and conditions of the Agreement; the court ordered probation; and meet all other requirements for licensure.

5. The Agreement and its contents shall become a part of the records maintained by the Board, and as such, is a public record subject to disclosure to the public, other licensing boards, and the National Association of Boards of Pharmacy.


6. The Registrant understands and agrees that his decision to enter into this Agreement and to accept the terms and conditions herein described is a final act and is not subject to reconsideration or judicial review.

7. The Registrant states that he has used legal counsel in connection with his decision to enter into this Agreement or, if he did not, that he had an opportunity to do so and that his decision to enter into this Agreement was made of his own free will.

8. Registrant certifies that he has read this document entitled "Consent Agreement". The Registrant understands that, by executing this Agreement, he is agreeing to the terms and conditions for registration by the Board.
