STATEWIDE DCR MULTI-USE TRAIL REPAIR PROGRAM SELECTED FY18 ACCOMPLISHMENTS

NASHUA RIVER RAIL TRAIL PAVEMENT REPAIRS AND SIGNAGE (\$153,988)

- Repaired and repaved 34 damaged path segments totaling 870 linear feet of bike trail
- Installed 11 new "destinations and distance" signs and 5 new "rules" signs
- Trimmed overhanging vegetation from 2500 linear feet of trail corridor



PAUL DUDLEY WHITE BIKE PATH BOSTON (\$330,050)

• Excavated and resurfaced 3,540 linear feet of the pathway between the BU Bridge and Bowker Pedestrian Footbridge.



MIDDLESEX FELLS RESERVATION TRAIL REPAIRS

• Constructed 287 feet rerouted trail to avoid sensitive areas and 106 feet of "French drain".







SOUTHERN NEW ENGLAND TRUNKLINE TRAIL (SNETT) RESTORATION (\$187,000)

- Restored 5,700 linear feet of the SNETT from Lake Street to Prospect Street, Bellingham with a stabilized aggregate accessible surface.
- Enhance trailhead parking and signage.
- Created safe trail crossing of Lake Street.



PITTSFIELD STATE FOREST TRAIL REPAIRS AND DRAINAGE IMPROVEMENTS

Repaired severely degraded and eroding sections of the motorized Skyline Trail.





WACHUSETT MOUNTAIN PINE HILL TRAIL STONE STEPS:

• Constructed 206 linear feet of stone stairs setting 34 steps and 105 gargoyles.
