STATEWIDE DCR MULTI-USE TRAIL REPAIR PROGRAM SELECTED FY19 ACCOMPLISHMENTS

MYSTIC RIVER GREENWAY PATH REPAIRS AND REPAVING (\$187,265)

- Completed 1,000 linear feet of full-depth path reconstructed
- Repaired an additional 90 root damage locations
- Repaved a total of 3,700 linear feet of shared-use pathway between Mystic Valley Parkway and Blessing of the Bay Park.



MT HOLYOKE RANGE STATE PARK TRAIL REPAIRS AND SIGN IMPROVEMENTS

- Installed stone steps to improve safety and access on the New England Trail
- Installed, in partnership with Kestrel Land Trust, 45 trail intersection signs



D.A.R. STATE FOREST ACCESSIBLE TRAIL RECONSTRUCTION (\$77,000)



D.A.R. STATE FOREST ACCESSIBLE TRAIL RECONSTRUCTION - CONTINUED

- Reconstructed the 2,450 linear foot Accessible Trail at Highland Lake
- Resurfaced with “Stabilized Aggregate” to improve accessibility for wheelchairs and elderly
- Installed 37 intersection trail signs to improve user safety and wayfinding

MT GREYLOCK STATE RESERVATION – CLASS 3 TRAIL RESTORATIONS



LEOMINSTER STATE FOREST – TRAIL SYSTEM ENHANCEMENTS (\$28,799)

- Three separate 10 day hitches of Student Conservation Association members...
- Installed over 40 trail intersection signs
- Completed ware bar and stone steps installation, and tread repairs



NASHUA RIVER RAIL TRAIL PAVEMENT REPAIRS AND SIGNAGE (\$80,013)

- Repaired and repaved 34 damaged path segments totaling 870 linear feet of bike trail
- Installed 11 new “destinations and distance” signs and 5 new “rules” signs
