

## **FY25 CSVS Grant Renewal**

The Massachusetts Office for Victim Assistance (MOVA) has opened the FY2025 renewal process for the Culturally Specific Victim Services in Western Massachusetts (CSVS) grant program on November 29, 2023. While all documents will be available on MOVA's website, the application will be completed and submitted via eGrants.

Only applicants who received a FY2024 CSVS award may apply. The contract duration will be for state fiscal year 2025, July 1, 2024 through June 30, 2025.
