Fair Share Surplus -Supplemental Budget

July 9, 2025



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- Surtax revenues collected in FY24 exceeded original projections. As a result, the Governor, House and Senate released supplemental budgets that allocate additional resources to the Education & Transportation Innovation and Capital Fund (ETF)
- On June 16, the Conference Committee released its version of the bill for the Governor's review, and the Governor signed into law on June 24.
- In this proposal, Transportation is allocated \$758.8 million, representing 55% of the total additional funding.
- The budget includes \$210.8 million, to support Chapter 90, RTAs, small bridges and culverts, unpaved roads, and local transportation projects.
