Dear Comptroller McNamara:

Pursuant to Section 20 of Chapter 28 of the 2023 Acts<sup>1</sup>, the Department of Revenue (DOR) is required to certify to the State Comptroller, after each quarterly period during the fiscal year, the amount of tax revenues estimated to have been collected during the quarterly period due to the additional 4% income tax levied pursuant to Article XLIV of the Amendments of the Constitution of the Commonwealth<sup>2</sup>.

The annual quarterly periods are as follows:

Period 1 (July 1 through September 30)Period 2 (October 1 through January 31)Period 3 (February 1 through April 30)Period 4 (May 1 through June 30)

The table below shows the additional 4% income tax revenue estimates for each of the first two certification periods, and on a year-to-date basis during fiscal year 2025.

Based on currently available data, DOR hereby certifies that tax revenue estimated to have been collected from the additional 4% income tax was \$646,129,756.17 during Period 2 of FY2025 (October 1, 2024 through January 31, 2025). The year-to-date (July 1, 2024 through January 31, 2025) tax revenue estimated to have been collected from the additional 4% income tax was \$1,070,560,192.25. Please note that these amounts are subject to revision in the Period 3 certification as DOR further analyzes tax data.
