Proposed Amendments to 211 CMR 66.00 Small Group Health Insurance

Pursuant to the authority granted to the Commissioner of Insurance ("Commissioner") under G.L. c. 176J, a public hearing will be held on May 12, 2022 at 11:00 a.m. to hear comments on proposed amendments to 211 CMR 66.00, Small Group Health Insurance. The hearing will be held virtually using TEAMS, a digital meeting program. Copies of the proposed amendments are available for inspection upon request to the Division of Insurance ("Division") at doi and are posted on the Division's website: http://www.mass.gov/doi

This regulation sets forth the Division's requirements for health insurance carriers that offer products in the individual and small-group merged health insurance market in the Commonwealth. The primary purpose of these changes to 211 CMR 66.00, is to simplify the merged-market health insurance rate filing process by, among other things, reducing the number of filings that need to be made (from quarterly to annual). The amendments also update the regulation to reflect the end of federal waivers that permitted the use of certain rating factors for small group plans.

This proceeding has been designated as Docket No. 2022-02. Any person requesting to comment orally at the virtual hearing must submit a Notice of Intent to Comment to doidocket.mailbox@mass.gov no later than May 10, 2022.
